







## Waste Disposal and Waste Separation in the Spree-Neisse district

Residual waste (black lid)	Light packaging (yellow lid)	Paper/cardboard/cardboard boxes (blue lid)	Organic waste (green lid)	Glass container	Bulky and electronic waste
					
<p>Basically all household <b>waste that is no longer recyclable</b>, for example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- dishes</li> <li>- small parts of rubber</li> <li>- old drugs</li> <li>- vacuum cleaner bags</li> <li>- wallpapers</li> <li>- used toiletries</li> <li>- diapers</li> <li>- hygiene products</li> <li>- dirty paper</li> <li>- cigarette butts</li> <li>- toothbrush.</li> </ul> <p><b>Hazardous waste</b>, like</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- liquid paints</li> <li>- chemicals,</li> </ul> <p>has to be disposed of using the hazardous waste collection vehicle.</p> <p>The dates and collection places can be found at: <a href="http://www.eigenbetrieb-abfallwirtschaft-lkspn.de">www.eigenbetrieb-abfallwirtschaft-lkspn.de</a>.</p>	<p><b>Packaging</b> made of metal, plastic or composite materials, for example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- yogurt cups</li> <li>- beverage cans</li> <li>- milk, juice cartons (Tetra Pak)</li> <li>- animal food cans</li> <li>- care product tubes</li> <li>- candy paper</li> <li>- detergent bottles</li> <li>- toothpaste tubes.</li> </ul> <p><i>Commodities and household items made of similar materials which are no sales packaging must not be included!</i></p>	<p>Only <b>clean materials</b> like <b>paper, cardboard, cardboard boxes</b> belong in the bin, for example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- newspapers</li> <li>- journals</li> <li>- folding boxes</li> <li>- cardboard boxes (flatten)</li> <li>- paper bags</li> <li>- catalogues</li> <li>- books</li> <li>- exercise books.</li> </ul> <p><i>Ones the materials are mixed with other substances they can no longer be recycled.</i></p>	<p><b>Biologically recyclable waste</b> from the kitchen and garden, for example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- fruit and food</li> <li>- leftover food</li> <li>- lawn clippings</li> <li>- compostable plant waste</li> <li>- coffee filter bags</li> <li>- leaves</li> <li>- windfall fruit</li> <li>- garden waste.</li> </ul> <p><i>Any kind of plastic bags, biodegradable bags as well, do not belong in the bio bin!</i></p>	<p><b>Jars and bottles</b> must be placed in the glass containers separated by colour – white, green and brown glass – for example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- beverage bottles</li> <li>- canning jars</li> <li>- screw jars</li> <li>- mustard jars</li> <li>- cough syrup bottles</li> <li>- face cream jars</li> <li>- perfume bottles.</li> </ul> <p><i>Under no circumstances do mirrors, car windows, aquariums or clay and ceramics belong in the glass container.</i></p> <p>Blue and red bottles belong in the green glass container. Green glass can best absorb other colour components.</p>	<p><b>Bulky waste</b>, for example tables, cupboards and floor coverings must be registered for collection. You can register by phone: 03562/6925-0 or by through: <a href="http://www.eigenbetrieb-abfallwirtschaft-lkspn.de">www.eigenbetrieb-abfallwirtschaft-lkspn.de</a>. Collection is free of charge.</p> <p>The disposal of bulky waste at recycling centers is subject to a fee!</p> <p><b>Large electronic devices</b>, for example refrigerators and washing machines can be registered for bulky waste collection.</p> <p><b>Small electronic scrap parts</b>, for example irons, razors and hair dryers, must be handed in at the recycling centers. If a large device has been registered for collection, small devices can be collected at the same time.</p>
